Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). In addition, the Wettfahrtordnung of the ASF, the Yardstick-Rating-Rules of the ASF, the General Sailing Instructions of the ASF, the additional Sailing Instructions of the UYCAs, as well as this Notice of Race apply.

If the class rules do not prescribe higher standards, ISO standard 12402-5 (or equivalent) is the minimum requirement for personal flotation devices. The use of inflatable flotation devices (automatic vests) is permitted only if explicitly permitted in the applicable class rules.

The anti-doping rules of World Sailing and the Austrian Anti-Doping-Bundesgesetz shall apply. Therefore doping suspended or blocked athletes and caregivers are not admitted to participate in the regatta.

The use of remote-controlled aircrafts (drones) over the regatta area by accompanying or supporting persons is - in addition to the legal regulations - only permitted if it has been registered with and approved by the organizer.

Advertising

[DP] Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

Eligibility

The event is open internationally to all solid wooden boats of the classes Sonderklasse, 22m² Rennjolle and O-Jolle, as well as all other keelboats and dinghies built before 1975 made of solid wood and/or steel and classified in the Yardstick class. Regardless of this rule, the organizer reserves the right to admit or deny boats. The mast and spars of the boats must be made of wood or aluminum.

All boats shall comply with the class rules and hold a third-party liability insurance.

The person in charge of each boat must be member of an ASF associated club, individual member of the ASF or another national association recognized by World Sailing. The person in charge must be in possession of the OeSV Junior Regatta License or the Bfa-inshore issued by the ASF or a Lake Constance skipper's license or be able to present an equivalent document from a foreign association.

The maximum number of persons on board is four for the Sonderklassen, three for the 22m² Rennjollen, and one for the O-Jollen. [DP]

A boat is only eligible to participate if it has completed registration.

Participant limit

There is a limit of 120 participants.

The order of participation will be based on the time of their entries.

Entry Deadline and minimum number of entries

A minimum of 3 boats of each class for the class events of Sonderklasse, 22m² Rennjolle, O-Jolle and Class Yardstick is required by the entry deadline (July 14th 2025). If this minimum number is not reached, the event may be canceled for the respective class.

Late entries will be accepted if received in time before the end of registration.

Registration

Check of measurement certificate, proof of liability insurance, ASF membership cards, and sailing license; distribution of sailing instructions:

Monday, July 28th, 2025, 15:00 to 18:00 hrs

Tuesday, July 29th, 2025, 09:00 to 10:00 hrs at the race office of the UYCAs.

Equipment Inspection

An equipment inspection will take place for the Sonderklassen on

Monday, July 28th, 2025, from 15:00 to 18:00 hrs.

Regardless, equipment inspections may be carried out for all participants throughout the event.

Tracking

All boats will be equipped with a tracking device for the "Lange Wettfahrt" on Saturday, August 2nd, 2025, which must be carried on board. The tracking system will be issued Friday evening and Saturday morning. A deposit of € 100,— in cash is required upon registration, which will be returned upon return of the tracking device after crossing the finish line.

First Warning Signal

Tuesday, July 29th, 2025, 12:00 hrs

Last Warning Signal

On Friday, August 1st, 2025, the whole day will be used for racing.. The last Warning Signal is that of the "Lange Wettfahrt" on August 2nd, 2025.

Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions are available at registration.

Courses

There will be sailed modern courses round marks with a target time of 50 minutes. An Saturday, August 2nd, 2025 the "Lange Wettfahrt" with start at 07:00 hrs will be sailed.

Penalty System

For all keelboats RRS 44.1 is changed so that the two turns penalty is replaced by the one turn penalty.



Scoring

8 races are scheduled from Tuesday, July 29th to Friday, August 1st. The "Lange Wettfahrt" will be sailed on Saturday, August 2nd.

Depending on the deed of gift, the individual races in the class regattas will be scored with or without rating and with or without the "Lange Wettfahrt" for the perpetual trophies.

The yardstick scoring is based on the ASF yardstick rules. Starting groups may be formed if there are sufficient participants.

The following applies in principle to the Atterseewoche class regattas:

8 races are scheduled. When 4 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

4 races must be completed to constitute a valid Austrian Championship for the Sonder-klassen.

2 races must be completed to constitute a valid Upper Austrian Championship for the Sonderklassen.

For the big overall ranking of the Ransonnet Cup, the calculated times of the regattas from Tuesday to Friday count (regardless of the different starting times of the starting groups), as well as those of the "Lange Wettfahrt", which has three scorings: Start - Burgau, Burgau - Finish, Start - Finish.

If the "Lange Wettfahrt" has to be abandoned for safety reasons or due to a storm warning (or if the time limit is reached at 17:00 hrs), the times of boats that did not finish will be extrapolated as finish time for the Atterseewoche rankings based on their position according to the tracking at the time of abandonment or at 17:00 hrs, using the following formula:

Calculated finish time = time until abandonment (or time limit) x total distance / (total distance - missing distance)

Berthing

[NP] [DP] Boats shall be kept in their assigned berthing places while in the harbour or boat parks.



Radio communication

[DP] Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

General

Competitors commit with their entry and/or participation to follow the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2025-2028, the rules of good seamanship and any other valid rules for this event as well as the regulations of the Austrian Sailing Federation and the legal standards and participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk in accordance with RRS 4 and accepting the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions.

The organizing authority, its associates and appointees accept no responsibility for any loss, damage, injury or inconvenience incurred, howsoever caused – ashore and afloat, for example those of crew, material and financial loss, as far as permitted by applicable law. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

In its entirety competitors agree to dispense with the assertion of claims for damages. The onus of presentation and the burden of proof in terms of the occurrence of damages is incumbent upon the competitors.

The organizing authority excludes liability for lost property or damage caused by third parties as well as unpredictable or unusual damage.

Recordings in sound and vision

By registering and/or participating, all participating persons declare that they agree that pictures and sound recordings of them and their boats/material may be taken and used for media coverage of the event and for their - also future - application, as well as for promoting the purposes of the organizing clubs may be published indefinitely.

Data

By registering and / or participating, all participants declare that they agree that the personal data they provide may be stored, used and passed on to higher-level sports organizations in the context of the organizational implementation of the event.

Minors

For underage competitors it is assumed parental consent by their legal representative has been given.

Other

The organisation of the event begins well in advance. Refunds of entry fee and travel expenses will not be provided. In exceptional cases(parts of)the entry fee (amounting to saved expenses) might be refunded -not in cases of force majeure.

Changes of the Notice of Race or other rules (eg sailing instructions) remain reserved, but will be announced in time.

All prizes (especially property and memory prizes) expire, if they are not taken during the prize giving ceremony.

The law of the Republic of Austria applies to questions that are not subject to the autonomy of the sport (association). The place of jurisdiction is the locally and factually competent court for Attersee am Attersee.

Worth knowing for our guests

Registration

The facilities of UYCAs are free available for guests which are registered for a regatta in the UYCAs for three days before and three days after the regatta (trailer and boat). For a longer duration of stay please ask and register in the office (sekretariat@uycas.at), this is only in exceptional cases possible.

If you arrive prior to the event please inform us obligatory that our harbormasters are available with the key for the gate and crane.

Youth accommodation

In the youth accommodation of UYCAs are limited places. Registration is required before closing date for the event. At registration in the office we ask for the payment of € 20,- per night for teenagers (€ 30,- per night for adults) for bedlinen, shower and cleaning.

Camping

For regatta guests arriving by camper, caravan or tent there is a campsite with a limited number of parking spaces in the club as well as sanitary facilities.

The use is only possible after an appointment per E-Mail to sekretariat@uycas.at and is possible only during the regatta or training event. The arrival is possible one day before the event and departure must be till noon after the event. Fee per night and camper, caravan or tent: € 30, -

Arrival

The best way to reach the Union-Yacht-Club Attersee is via A1 motorway. Leave A1 at exit "St. Georgen im Attergau". At the end of the motorway's exit turn left to direction "Attersee". Follow the road until you are in the village of Attersee and turn right at the T-crossing in Attersee to direction "Unterach am Attersee". About 1 km later, you reach UYCAs. There is a pedestrian crossing in front of the club.

Site map

In the information E-Mail we'll send you a code for our gates. You can open the gate to the parking area and the "Tor Süd" (situated shore-based on the right side of the street). Through the "Tor Süd" you'll come to the trailer parking area and to the rigging ladder. Please prepare everything there before you move to the berth or to the crane. For an organised flow of the event please park your trailer and car at the provided parking areas.
